

THE JARROW MARCH ARRIVES IN MILTON KEYNES

On Sunday 30 October, members of the GMB Milton Keynes City Branch joined other Trade Unionists and Anti Cuts campaigners in welcoming the Youth Fight for Jobs marchers to Milton Keynes.

The YFFJ were recreating the famous Jarrow March of 1936 by walking the 330 miles from Jarrow to London.

Having left Jarrow on 1 October these inspirational young people planned to arrive in Trafalgar Square on 5 November.
